<b>Additional Information:</b> <p>I am pleased to inform you that your office will receive funding under the Aid to Prosecution – Illegal Fentanyl Prosecution Grant Program for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-24. This grant program was secured by Governor Kathy Hochul and the New York State Legislature to help local law enforcement efforts to disrupt the supply of illegal fentanyl.</p> <p>Rather than issuing your grant award through a DCJS contract, the full award amount will be directly and automatically disbursed to your county in one payment to then be provided to the district attorney's office.</p> <p>Please note that this funding is provided to support local efforts to disrupt the flow of illegal fentanyl and offset the cost of personnel, including those assigned to specialized units, and equipment to increase prosecution of cases where individuals overdose.</p> <p>This funding may be used to cover costs incurred on or after April 1, 2023. As this funding is being provided as a block grant, the funding will remain available to the office until it is fully expended. DCJS requests that the county promptly make these funds available to the recipient district attorney's office.</p> <p>Please also note that the above reference to the SFY 2023-24 date of April 1, 2023 is included for State budgeting purposes only and is not intended to interfere with local budgetary planning, which typically operates on a different fiscal calendar.</p> <p>Please email any questions to the DCJS units provided below.
