RE: APPROVAL OF A MASTER AGREEMENT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES, AND TASK ORDER NO. 1 THEREUNDER, BETWEEN ONEIDA COUNTY, THROUGH ITS DEPARTMENT OF WATER QUALITY AND WATER POLLUTION CONTROL, AND ENVIRONMENTAL DESIGN & RESEARCH, LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE, ENGINEERING & ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, D.P.C.

WHEREAS, This Board is in receipt of a Master Agreement for Engineering Services between Oneida County, through its Department of Water Quality and Water Pollution Control, and Environmental Design & Research, Landscape Architecture, Engineering & Environmental Services, D.P.C. (“EDR”), to provide engineering services in connection with the planning, design, and construction administration for sewer rehabilitation projects across the Oneida County Sewer District service area, such services to be memorialized in task orders issued pursuant to the agreement, and

WHEREAS, The Master Agreement for Engineering Services shall be for a term commencing upon its execution and continuing for five years, with up to five additional renewal terms of one year each, and

WHEREAS, This Board is in receipt of Task Order No. 1, issued pursuant to the Master Agreement for Engineering Services, pursuant to which EDR will provide preliminary engineering services for the Deerfield Sewer Shed Rehabilitation Project, such Task Order No. 1 being for a schedule commencing upon its execution and ending December 31, 2025, and for a fee not to exceed \$508,500.00, and

WHEREAS, In accordance with Oneida County Charter Section 2202, said Master Agreement for Engineering Services, and Task Order No. 1 issued thereunder, must be approved by the Oneida County Board of Legislators, now, therefore, be it hereby

RESOLVED, That the Oneida County Board of Legislators hereby approves of and authorizes Oneida County Executive, Anthony J. Picente, Jr., to execute a Master Agreement for Engineering Services between Oneida County, through its Department of Water Quality and Water Pollution Control, and Environmental Design & Research, Landscape Architecture, Engineering & Environmental Services, D.P.C., for a term commencing upon its execution and continuing for five years, including any extensions of time or non-material amendments, and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Oneida County Board of Legislators hereby approves of and authorizes Oneida County Executive, Anthony J. Picente, Jr., to execute Task Order No. 1 between Oneida County, through its Department of Water Quality and Water Pollution Control, and Environmental Design & Research, Landscape Architecture, Engineering & Environmental Services, D.P.C., for a schedule commencing upon its execution and ending December 31, 2025, and for a total fee not to exceed \$508,500.00, including any extensions of time or non-material amendments.
