**RE: APPROVAL OF AN INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN ONEIDA COUNTY, THROUGH ITS DEPARTMENT OF WATER QUALITY AND WATER POLLUTION CONTROL, AND CERTAIN ONEIDA COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT CONSTITUENT MUNICIPALITIES IN RELATION TO NEW YORK STATE ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITIES CORPORATION FUNDS FOR THE PLANNING, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECTS IN VARIOUS LOCATIONS ACROSS THE ONEIDA COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT SERVICE AREA**

**WHEREAS,** This Board is in receipt of an Intermunicipal Agreement between Oneida County, through its Department of Water Quality and Water Pollution Control, and certain municipalities within the Oneida County Sewer District providing for the preservation of access rights, and continuance of public ownership, of each such municipality's sewer collection and conveyance systems during such times as improvements to such systems are financed through the Environmental Facilities Corporation, and

**WHEREAS,** The municipal counterparties to the Intermunicipal Agreement are the City of Utica, the Village of New York Mills, the Village of Yorkville, the Village of Whitesboro, the Village of Oriskany, the Village of New Hartford, the Village of Clayville, the Town of Whitestown, the Town of New Hartford, the Town of Paris, the Town of Deerfield and the Town of Frankfort (collectively, the "Municipalities"), and

**WHEREAS,** Said Agreement is for a term commencing upon its execution and terminating at such time as any bonds or outstanding debt related to the improvement projects are fully paid, satisfied and discharged, and

**WHEREAS,** Said Agreement must be approved by the Oneida County Board of Legislators, now, therefore, be it hereby

**RESOLVED,** That the Oneida County Board of Legislators hereby approves of and authorizes Oneida County Executive, Anthony J. Picente, Jr., to execute an Intermunicipal Agreement between Oneida County, through its Department of Water Quality and Water Pollution Control, and the Municipalities, for a term commencing upon its execution and terminating at such time as any bonds or outstanding debt related to the improvement projects are fully paid, satisfied and discharged.
