### Summary Statements

- 1) Narrative Description of Proposed Services: The Department of Water Quality and Water Pollution Control (“Department”) seeks to retain Arcadis of New York, Inc. (“Arcadis”) to perform engineering services in connection with the planning, design, and construction administration for sewer rehabilitation across the Oneida County Sewer District service area. The Department issued a request for qualifications and upon review of the submissions from consultant firms, along with in-person interviews, Arcadis was determined by the selection team to be one of the two highest-rated firms for this particular project based on its extensive experience in the planning, design, and construction administration of sewer rehabilitation projects. The Department seeks approval of a Master Agreement for Consulting Services (“Agreement”) with Arcadis—for a five year term with up to five optional one-year renewals—along with approval of Task Order No. 1 (Preliminary Design Services for the Starch Factory Creek Sewer Shed). The Department will submit any new task orders to the Board of Legislators for approval, as they arise. The schedule for Task Order No. 1 will begin upon execution and end December 31, 2025. Its total price will not exceed \$495,000.00.
- 2) Program/Service Objectives and Outcomes: Provide critical consulting and engineering services.
- 3) Program Design and Staffing: Systems will continue to be operated by Department of Water Quality and Pollution Control Staff.
