

911 DIVERSION PROGRAM CONTRACT EXTENSION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between Oneida County, a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, having its principal office at 800 Park Avenue, Utica, New York, including its Department of Emergency Services, located at 120 Base Road, Oriskany, New York 13424 (collectively, the “County”), and Innovative Practices, LLC, a limited liability corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, located at 6363 S. Fiddler’s Green Circle, Suite 1500, Greenwood Village, Colorado 80111 (the “Provider”).

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Provider has developed a proprietary 911 telephone call diversion program which matches low acuity 911 callers with an appropriate level of care and response (the “services”); and

WHEREAS, the parties previously entered a one-year agreement for the services, effective May 18, 2023 through May 17, 2024 (Oneida County Contract No. 175914) (the “Original Contract”), and now wish to extend the Original Contract for a period of six (6) months.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein contained, the parties do hereby agree to extend the Original Contract, as follows:

1. **Term:** The term of the Original Contract shall be extended to run for an additional six-month period, from May 18, 2024 through November 17, 2024 (the “Extension Period”);
2. **Compensation:** During the Extension Period, the County will pay the Provider Fifteen Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy-Seven Dollars (\$15,777.00) per month, for a total of Ninety-Four Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars (\$94,662.00) for the Extension Period;
3. **Other Terms:** All other terms and conditions of the Original Contract, a copy of which is annexed hereto as Exhibit A, shall remain in full force and effect.
