SUMMARY STATEMENTS

1). Narrative Description of Proposed Services:

The purpose of this grant is to allocate funds toward staffing for street outreach services that provide assistance to people who are homeless. Street outreach workers engage with people residing in places not meant for human habitation and assist the Department's after-hours support line staff to assess people for immediate safety and shelter placement needs. Workers communicate with community providers such as first responders, law enforcement, hospitals, and housing agencies to identify needs and find shelter for homeless individuals and families.

2). Program/Service Objectives and Outcomes -

These funds will be utilized to support street outreach staffing expenses incurred while assisting vulnerable people who are homeless, specifically those residing in locations not suitable for habitation.
