Attached, please find an agreement that requires both Board of Legislators action and your signature between the Oneida County Stop-DWI Program and the Village of New York Mills, through its New York Mills Police Department. This agreement provides funding for the Village of New York Mills to conduct High Visibility Engagement Campaigns, formerly called Crackdown Patrols, during the holidays. This funding is 100% reimbursable to Oneida County from a grant received from the New York State Stop-DWI Foundation. No County dollars are needed for this contract.

I am respectfully requesting that this contract with the Village of New York Mills be approved as a template agreement by the Board of Legislators for all listed police agency conduct High Visibility Engagement Campaigns contracts, which are all the same content, except for agency name, locality, and dollar amount.
