RE: APPROVAL OF AN INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN ONEIDA COUNTY THROUGH ITS DEPARTMENT OF WATER QUALITY AND WATER POLLUTION CONTROL AND THE NINE SEWER DISTRICT CONSTITUENT MUNICIPALITIES ALLOWING CERTAIN ACCESS RIGHTS NEEDED TO FINANCE AND COMPLETE SEWER INVESTIGATIONS AND REPAIRS NECESSITATED BY A DEC CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, County Executive Anthony J. Picente, Jr. is in receipt of correspondence from the Commissioner of Water Quality and Water Pollution Control requesting approval of an Intermunicipal Agreement between Oneida County and the nine Constituent Municipalities, that are subject to the DEC consent order, granting Environmental Facilities Corporation and DEC access to sewer infrastructure of Oneida County and the Towns of Paris, New Hartford and Whitestown and the Villages of Clayville, New York Mills, Yorkville, Whitesboro, Oriskany and New Hartford, and

WHEREAS, Said Agreement must be approved by the Oneida County Board of Legislators, now, therefore, be it hereby

RESOLVED, That County Executive Anthony J. Picente, Jr. is hereby authorized and directed to execute an Agreement between Oneida County and the Towns of New Hartford, Paris and Whitestown and the Villages of Clayville, New Hartford, New York Mills, Oriskany, Whitesboro and Yorkville granting the Environmental Facilities Corporation and the DEC access to the County infrastructure as well as the sewer infrastructure of the named municipalities in order to facilitate the funding of Phases 1 and 2A by the EFC.
