### Summary Statements

- 1) **Narrative Description of Proposed Services:** The purpose of this Agreement is to provide technical and professional services for rabies vaccine administration to domestic dogs, cats and ferrets. The Environmental Health Division is responsible for monitoring diseases that animals may transmit to humans. Rabies, which is invariably fatal, is the most significant of these diseases. Public Health Law requires making rabies vaccination clinics available for all dogs, cats, and ferrets.
- 2) **Program/Service Objectives and Outcomes:** To administer vaccines during clinic hours at locations pre-arranged and agreed to by the County and Contractor.
- 3) **Program Design and Staffing:** Veterinarians and Vet Technicians per the contract specifications.
